They have toured the US east coast extensively, played all over the Greater Toronto Area and played some well-reviewed sets at Montreal 77, Montebello Rock, NXNE, Indie Week, Canadian Music Week, Pouzza Fest, Beau's Oktoberfest as well as many others. The band has just completed a recent massively successful European tour supporting the Creepshow. They have also had the opportunity to open for international acts such as The Flatliners, The Offspring, MxPx, The Adicts and the Planet Smashers, just to name a few.

The band's label debut full length LP has just been released on Stomp Records and has amassed more than 150 000 streams on Spotify already. The opening single « Worse Than Death » has been added to the rotation on many Canadian commercial radio stations, including two of Canada's biggest rock stations, CHOM (Montreal) and Indie 88 (Toronto) as well as Sirius XM's The Verge.
